English electroplate silver: marks and hallmarks of ...

Common base metals include copper, brass, nickel silver an alloy of copper, zinc and nickel and Britannia metal a tin alloy with 5-10% antimony. Electroplated materials are often stamped EPNS for electroplated nickel on silver, or EPBM for electroplated Britannia metal.
