September 28, 1787: The Congress agrees to send the Constitution to the states for debate and ratification.
December 7, 1787: Delaware ratifies. Vote: 30 for, 0 against.

Order of States in Ratification of the US Constitution

Ratification did not come easily or without opposition. Led by Patrick Henry of Virginia, a group of influential colonial Patriots known as the Anti Federalists publicly opposed the new Constitution in town hall meetings, newspapers, and pamphlets.

Ratification of Constitutional Amendments The U.S ...

Article 5 of the Constitution provides for the amendment of the Constitution by various means (see The Amendments Page for details). However an amendment is proposed, it does not become part of the Constitution unless it is ratified by three quarters of the states (either the legislatures thereof, or in amendment conventions).

April 28 • Ratification. Maryland becomes the seventh state to ratify the Constitution (63–11). May 12 • Ratifying convention begins in South Carolina. May 23 • Ratification. South Carolina becomes the eighth state to ratify the Constitution (149–73).
