Machu Picchu is situated above a bow of the Urubamba River, which surrounds the site on three sides, where cliffs drop vertically for 450 metres (1,480 ft) to the river at their base.

Machu Picchu is located at 2,400 masl (7,874 fasl), on the top of the plateau located between two peaks. From these two, the smallest, the Huayna Picchu is the one that defines the topography of the site.
